

WESLA FEDERAL CREDIT UNION MEMBERS STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

We strive to provide for our members, employees, committee members, directors and other members of the public a pleasant and safe environment here at the Credit Union. Accordingly, it shall be against Credit Union Policy for any member to engage in the following activities while on Credit Union property or while conducting Credit Union business:

- 1. Possession or use of, or being under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants while on Credit Union property
- 2. Theft or attempted theft of Credit Union property
- 3. Intentional destruction, loss or waste of, or damage to Credit Union property
- 4. Possession of firearms or other dangerous weapons. (Except for only authorized law enforcement personnel
- 5. Use of threatening, obscene, profane, abusive or harassing language or conduct toward any member, employee, committee member or directors at any time or to any other person.
- 6. Intentional infliction of bodily harm to any member, employee, committee member or director at any time, or to any other person.

Failure to adhere to the standards set forth above will subject the individual to immediate termination from their membership/employment in the Credit Union.
