



WESLA FEDERAL CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION





Award Amount

Two (2) \$1,000 WESLA Federal Credit Union scholarships will be awarded to two (2) graduating seniors. The recipients will be selected based on individual contributions to the school and community.

Eligibility

Applicant must be a member in good standing with WESLA Federal Credit Union. The applicant must register for college as a full-time student no later than the beginning of the fall semester of 2021. The applicant must have a GPA (Grade Point Average) of 2.50 or higher.

Application Process

Eligible members must complete and sign the scholarship application and submit all requested documentation with the application. Please check off all documents as received.

- Completed (typed) application
- Transcript of high school courses completed to date.
- An SAT/ACT transcript (obtained through your high school guidance office).
- Three (3) letters of recommendations, including two (2) from a high school administrator or teacher.
- A list of all other scholarships received.
- Acceptance letter from accredited college.
- Typed essay of no more than 250 words on – “What are Your Plans for the Next Ten Years”.
- A recent photograph to be used for marketing purposes only. Photo will not be submitted to committee with application. Photos may be returned upon request.

If any portion of this packet is incomplete or required documents are not included, the application will not be considered.

Selection Process

All applications must be a member of WESLA Federal Credit Union in good standing before an application will be considered. All applications will be based on academic performance, essay, community activities and personal goals. Each application will be evaluated by an independent panel of educators. The panel will be chaired by a member of the WESLA Board of Directors with four (4) other appointed educators. The selection by the panel will be final. Strict adherence to the rules and qualifications will be maintained. Application will be furnished by and submitted to WESLA Federal Credit Union. Funds will be paid directly to the college and credited to the student as required.
