
You've just unpacked the last box from what was an at-best overly stressful move. The last thing you want to do is surf every crevice of Google to identify all the places you need to change your address. You'd rather be investigating pizza delivery options-are we right? Cheese, please.

We've got your (probably aching) back so you can get back to making your new place a home. Though every mover's circumstances are unique, this list should help cover your main bases.

- Government agencies
- Financial services
- Utilities
- Insurance
- People and animal care
- Online services
- Memberships

To change your address at WESLA FCU login to your Online Banking or stop by a Branch and complete paperwork with proof of change.





- Be judicious with whom you share your personal information and social security number and never share your social with anyone through email.
- Report lost and stolen cards immediately
- Shred all materials in a home shredder that have important information on them such as your full name, date of birth, account numbers, etc.
- Use anti-virus software on your computer.
- Don't open emails or attachments from people you do not recognize.
- Protect your password(s).
- Change passwords frequently and make them difficult to guess.
- Review and reconcile your banking transactions on a regular basis.
- Do not open email or answer telephone requests for information from people you do not know.
- Where possible, enable multi-factor authentication (MFA) or out of band authentication if not enabled by default.
- Verify use of a secure session in your browser online banking and vendor payments.
- Do not leave your computer unattended and close your computer sessions when not in use.
- Check your credit report annually.

Ways to Keep your Account Safe

Think Like A Detective – Thoroughly read and review your statements whether paper or online. Although it is time consuming it is important to read line by line will help you identify discrepancies and charges that are not yours.

Build Strong Locks- A unique password acts as a deadbolt on your online accounts. To build a strong password, you need to include a mix of uppercase and lowercase letters, special characters. and numbers. Avoid public Wi-Fi- Using a public wireless access to check your account or pay bills is a risky move. Anytime you access your account for any reason, you need to use a wireless signal that is password protected. Opt for Alerts - This way your account is constantly monitored.


